Procedure:

This procedure is for the clear understanding of the department's views and safety issues with the caring of a Concealed Weapon [CCW] on the fire ground.

- A. When a firefighter is in possession of a valid CCW and has a weapon on their person, that weapon shall be removed from the person and secured before entering into the department buildings or onto the fire ground.
- B. It will not be the responsibility of Shepherd Tri-Twp Fire Department to make means or accessibility of storage of any weapon.
- C. Should it be that firefighters happen to be on the fire ground with a weapon on their person, they should immediately report to the Incident Commander and advise them of the situation.
- D. It shall be the sole duty of the Fire Chief to discipline a firefighter that has disregarded this policy. The Fire Chief may use the disciplinary policy or may discipline the firefighter as he or she deems necessary.

Procedure Overview/Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to assure firefighter safety and the public's safety at the stations and on the fire ground.
